- Dan Thibault (Tee-bo) started employment on February 1. I was informed on the 21st that there was a problem with Dan's application to the academy. Namely that an offense he had in Nevada 17 years ago required further inspection. On February 28th the state informed me that they had resolved the question and Dan's application could continue.
- Cory Flor has moved completely out and Jon Dunlap has moved completely into the office.
- Steve Flanagan has reached his 6 month employment anniversary and is eligible to come off "county probation" and receive a \$0.50 per hour wage increase (from \$16.60 to \$17.10 per hour). Steve's next increase will come after he successfully completes the academy, which will be another \$0.50 / hour raise. I will have Steve's evaluation filed in the auditor's office soon.

TRAINING:

- The full time and part time law enforcement staff all completed annual taser training and basic first aid / CPR / and AED training hosted by the Miller Police Department.
- We will have annual domestic violence training on March 15, 2017.
- I would like permission to attend the spring conference for the sheriff's and police chiefs to be held in Deadwood. This would include registration, lodging and meals.
