### PERSONNEL

- **The 24-7 sobriety program refunded us \$161 (TR 49356)** which is deposited into the 24/7 fund. This represents 161 days of testing by people on the SCRAM bracelet / anklet at one dollar each day they are paid on time. Delinquent accounts result in forfeiture of the refund. The funds can only be spent on 24/7 related items. We currently do not have any unmet needs. This means we are doing our job right!
- **Deputy recruitment:** I have two applications presently. I will schedule interviews for next week. I am expecting one more application. The certified officer seeking to work part time to maintain his certification took a job elsewhere so that will not be happening. The two certified officers I mentioned to you last month have not submitted any application paperwork.
