

Newsletter & Commission Report June 7, 2018

PERSONNEL:

- Deputy Anderson started in May and is living in St. Lawrence.
- Deputy Wik started in March and lives in Miller.
- Both are still in their orientation / probationary period of employment.
- The “unscheduled part-time” deputies have not been needed much this past month since both full time deputy positions have been filled. Two of them, Deputies Brummel (FT Hyde Co deputy) and Dunlap (FT Game Warden) were the two who investigated and arrested the large drug case in early May. They will have some hours as the result of that.

TRAINING:

- Deputy Anderson and Reggie attended a day long training exercise in Chamberlain the last week of May. Both will attend “annual” recertification training on June 15.
- Deputy Wik will, most likely, attend the basic academy in Pierre in the fall.

OPERATIONS:

- In the next six months I will be working on cleaning up unfinished business, clearing up evidence and other property in the office.

EQUIPMENT:

- **State Radio Equipment:** We have two mobile units out of service. Apparently the cable between the trunk mounted transceiver and dash mounted controller shorted out burning out components in the transceivers. The units are in Sioux Falls to determine if they are repairable.
- **Shotgun:** I have not purchased the shotgun yet. I am soliciting / researching prices presently to determine the best deal.
- **New Vehicle:** I provided the car I was driving (the 2017 Ford) to Deputy Anderson because his kennel was designed for such a vehicle. I in turn took the 2008 GMC Envoy. Despite reports from employees, the Envoy does not need to be replaced. It has just over 100K mile on it and should last another year (maybe two) unless something major happens. I have some simple repairs to make on the vehicle to keep it road worthy but noting significant. Therefore, I will not be asking to replace a vehicle this fall or in next year’s budget.
- I am replacing two desktop computers with remanufactured computers purchased online, each with an extended 3 year warranty. I am paying roughly ¼ of retail, or just about the amount it would cost just to purchase Windows 10 off the shelf.

- **2017-2018 Highway Safety Grant:** The FY2019 grant was submitted online and we are awaiting an award announcement.
- Chelsea Kendrick has submitted the reimbursement requests for the overtime / regular hours spent on the program and I received notification that payment was approved.
- **Drug Control Fund:** I corresponded with Jon Bierne of the DCI about making application to the fund for equipment related to the K9 program. SA Bierne informed me that awards had recently been given so applications can be written now and submitted for consideration at the next meeting. Deputy Anderson received letters from others who had used the program and I will have him write up an application letter for the equipment.
