PERSONNEL

- Deputy Steven Flanagan has submitted his resignation and will be leaving the sheriff's office in the near future. I have him on the schedule through August. Deputy Flanagan has offered to stay while we search for a replacement. **I ask the board to formally accept this resignation.** Deputy Flanagan would have had his one year anniversary on September 1.
- Deputy Daniel Thibault is scheduled to attend the academy beginning August 20th through November.
- Deputy Thibault is also approaching his six month anniversary. Deputy Thibault's six month review is favorable for him to move from probationary employee to regular employee (while the law enforcement probation of one year still continues until successful certification). **Thus I ask the board to recognize the transition and to also raise Deputy Thibault's wage one step, \$0.50/hour from \$16.12 to \$16.62 per hour.**

TRAINING:

- We hosted the annual summer (DCI-instructed) handgun and shot gun qualification at the range on July 12. It was well attended (excluding me, as I was ill that day). The DCI provides the instructor and the ammunition and we do not have to travel for this training.

EQUIPMENT:

- The 2008 GMC Envoy will need a new set (of four) tires soon. **I ask for spending approval** to purchase the tires after seeking competitive quotes for them.

GRANTS

- **2016-2017 Highway Safety Grant:** We are approaching the year end for this program and will transition to the FY2018 program at the end of September.
- We will start holding our own SOBRIETY CHECK POINTS beginning in August 2017.
- **2017-2018 Highway Safety Grant:** No new activity.
- **Bullet Proof Partnership Grant:** I applied for this program but was not able to successfully submit all the data needed and thus missed this opportunity. The grant website indicated that they had received nearly twice the applications of previous years and consequently the deadline was extended but only so many agencies would receive awards. I also provided Deputy Thibault with a (non-local) foundation grant application where he could acquire a vest through their application process. No response has been seen.
