## Newsletter & Commission Report October 3, 2017

### PERSONNEL

- Deputy Steve Flanagan resigned as a full time deputy sheriff in resignation but did not declare his last day of employment at that time. Deputy Flanagan submitted an amended resignation stating his last day of full time employment is September 30 and his desire to remain with the county as an unscheduled part time employee. Deputy Flanagan's intent is to try and help when possible until regular deputies can be hired. I ask that the commission accept the amended resignation and to reclassify Deputy Flanagan as a part time deputy sheriff.
- I currently have one (incomplete) application for the open deputy sheriff's position. As has been seen in the past, the number of applications submitted is very low. This is a trend I have spoken to other department heads about. The last opening at the Miller Police Department resulted in only two applications. I do have two people interested in working part-time to maintain their certification. Any opposition to that?
- **Deputy recruitment:** I have prepared the wage scale approved last month so it can be incorporated into the county policy manual and prepared a description of the wage scale was configured and how it sets our deputies apart from someone who does patrol work only. I ask that the commission incorporate this wage scale and attached explanation into policy.
