

Newsletter & Commission Report

**PERSONNEL**

- **Deputy recruitment:** I have offered a deputy position to **Shawn Wik** who accepted. His first day was yesterday. I am asking the commission to ratify his employment as an entry level deputy sheriff with a starting wage of \$18.00 per hour.
- I am still in the process of searching for the second deputy sheriff. The Department of Labor ad was placed back on their website.

**TRAINING:**

- Chelsea Kendrick attended training on the renovations to the 24/7 sobriety program. The training was in Pierre and hosted by the website / device manufacturer. I wanted to attend but did not have coverage to allow both of us to leave.

**OPERATIONS:**

- I spoke with **Attorney General Marty Jackley** on 2-27-18 and he explained how the "drug control fund" can help agencies cover the expenses associated with detection, prevention and prosecution of drug related offenses, including but not limited to K9 purchases and equipment (vehicle inserts). We also spoke about staffing issues. He explained that the DCI has also struggled to find suitable recruits.

**EQUIPMENT:**

- **State Radio Equipment:** The last time we updated the state radio equipment was after receiving the 2007 federal grant called PSIC. The state radios use the states tower systems for statewide operation on a digital format. Our local system uses analog. The region Emergency Management area decided by straw poll to use this years and future years Homeland Security Grant to purchase replacement equipment. The estimated expense is about \$3K each. The state plans to upgrade their portion of the system in 2023 if not sooner (depending on funds). This is an expense to keep in mind (since the HLS grant is competitive and fluctuates in size, the county may need to budget for replacements in the coming years, probably replacing one a year if grant funding is not available. Presently I have one unit in the shop for repairs. It may be terminal.
- **Portable Breathe Tester:** We completed the purchase of the new PBT. The price of CMI, Inc. unit at \$349 is more than half of what our other units cost.
- **Old custom made desk:** We spoke to Steve Resel about taking the wood from the old desk and making a radiator / shelf from the wood. He said it was possible so we did not discard the desk, but plan to recycle it. There will be labor expense but it will be minimal.

**GRANTS:**

- **2017-2018 Highway Safety Grant:** We are working on our monthly reports and reimbursement requests.
