#### PERSONNEL:

#### EQUIPMENT:

- **Cellular Phones:** I have decided to suspend the switch in the cellular phone plan and let the next sheriff decide how he wants to proceed.
- Chelsea Price and I are going through property in the sheriff's office. We have found several items which need to be **surplused**. None of it, so far, is worth selling. We will prepare a list of items which can be destroyed, discarded, recycled or given to another public safety agency for consideration at the November meeting.
