

In Section 4 Definitions for an occupied residence. I believe that saying an Occupied Residence is a dwelling, mobile home, or manufactured home which has been occupied “during the” 2 yrs. immediately preceding an application for a wind energy permit is a better definition than saying occupied “for” 2 years immediately preceding an application for a wind energy permit. Why? Because the residence may have not been inhabited for the preceding 2 yrs. for the entire 2 yrs. (i.e. snowbirds, change of occupants)

Also, there is no language in this document that addresses shadow flicker. There needs to be something to the effect that “No WES can produce any shadow flicker on a non-participating occupied residence.” 30 hours annually is simply not acceptable. We should not have to shut our blinds and be robbed of our views because of this nuisance.
