Auditor's Comment: Please keep in mind that in the general fund, you have one more FTE in the general fund and three in the road & bridge fund at a cost of about \$55,000 each.

There is a 18.05% match on the (about 10) bridge replacements applied for in 2021. The estimate is about \$72,000 on each \$400,000 structure.

The reimbursement from the CARES act fund was essentially used to purchase the 10 acres for the rubble site and pay the remaining balance of the crawler at the rubble site. About \$102,000 of the \$136,000. It is likely that the recovered 911 funds will be required to be placed back into the 911 fund.

The alcohol reversion monies were allocated to recurring budget increases already, including sheriff, coroner, states attorney, court appointed attorney.

If you choose to continue support of the OHDC, that would be \$30,000 (unless you choose to change it) a year.
